FREE SUMMER PROGRAMS

Beading Workshop - 9am – 12pm

This is a beginner's class. Its aim is to introduce children, with little experience in beading, to the art of sewing and beading the Mardi Gras Indians patches. They will learn principles of design and will bead a small patch/square in the style of the New Orleans Mardi Gras Indians aesthetic. To that end, students will learn about types of beads and their visual effects in a design, how colors help in creating a design and/or a visual impact, and the basic style of sewing to attach the beads to a patch/square. Students will display/present their final product on the last day of the workshop.

Percussion Workshop - 1pm – 4pm

This is a beginner's class. Its aim is to introduce children to the different types of percussion instruments, their sounds and their complementary function in a band or musical group. Generally, percussion instruments make sounds when shaken, hit, or scraped. Drums, cymbals, tambourine, bells and clave are some popular percussion instruments. Students will learn the Mardi Gras Indians style of music using specific instruments and voice. Students will give a musical presentation on the last day of the workshop.
